KHUVSGUL PROVINCE**

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## **CHAPTER ONE**

### **AIMAG'S CURRENT LEVEL, JUSTIFICATIONS, NEEDS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR CHILD FRIENDLY AIMAG STRATEGY**

#### **1.1. Background and justification**

Child is physically, mentally and socially immature, thus, innocent. Therefore, before and after his or her birth, child protections and cares, including legal regulations are essential.

In recognition of child immaturity and the essentiality of child protections and cares, a concept, phrased as a child friendly society has served to express our general thoughts, concerns and consensus on shaping child friendly societies and environment. In order to ensure the conditions on child friend society, both government and non-government organizations and even private sectors are required to determine policies with respect to the rationale of child friend society and then put them into practice.

These requirements for them are in fact legitimized and enforced by acts and other legal documents such as Law on the Protection of Child Rights (1966); Memorandum of Understanding between the Government of Mongolia and UNICEF (2010); Millennium Challenge Goals /1990-2015/; Conclusions and Recommendations of Child Right Commission in UN /1996, 2000, 2005, 2010 /; Child Right Convention in UN/1989/, Family Law and acts and other legal regulations on prevention of family violence. The above-mentioned legal framework also underlies the establishment of child friendly policies and government services that can ensure child protection and safety and health environment.

#### **1.2. Needs and requirements**

Khuvsgul is one of western aimags which locates distantly from the capital and densely-populated and vastly stretched as compared to other remote ones. 37.8% out of the whole population are youths aged to 18 which amount to 47142. By indicators of mortality rate, poverty rate, child crime rate, unemployment rate, it is also ranked higher among other aimags in Mongolia. Consequently, by human development index, it has been lowered and ranked at the 21<sup>st</sup> place among others.

Such worsened circumstances in this aimag has negatively affected current situation to ensure four fundamental rights of child, to establish safety and healthy environment, build infrastructure for clean water and sanitation.

With reference to the relevant documents, namely, the National Annual Statistics 2012-2013; the Report of child development study -2012; Indicators and level of child friendly aimag; Annual statistics by organizations 2013, what we have figured out is as follows:

### **1. 2.1. Regarding child protection, participation, development:**

- None of government and non-government organizations that pursue any child protection policies /2013 statistical book, DFCYD/
- None of centers established for family councils in any aimags / Statistics 2013, DFCYD /
- None of programs and hours allocated in local media dedicated to children /Statistics 2013, DFCYD/
- A number of children witnessed by punishments whereby they were physically and psychologically hurt. /MICS-2012/
- 20,1% out of the whole children under reproductive age who tends to tolerate with family violence and it is two times higher than the national average /MICS-2012/
- The development index of children aged under about 12 is 76,6%, and it is 8,5% more than the national average of that /MICS-2012/

### **1.2. 2. Regarding education:**

- There were no kindergartens with any infrastructures and equipment for water cleaning or filtering and sanitation in 2012 whereas 25.6% out of the whole kindergartens were equipped with that equipment /Statistics of the Department of Education, 2013/
- Percentage of children with kindergarten age who are prepared for schools is 73.6%, it is 16,9% less than the national average of that / MICS-2012/
- Enrollment rate of children in pre-school education is 54% and its 5% less than the national average of that /XXC-2012/
- Enrollment rate of children in primary and secondary schools is 92% / MICS-2012/ )

### **1.2.3. Regarding health:**

- Maternal death rate per 100 000 live births in 2012 is 31.3 pro mil in 2012 whereas that is 91 pro mil in 2013. It is 2.1 times more than the national average of that (42.6 pro mil) /Statistics of the department of health 2013/
- Child death rate aged under 1 per 1000 live births is 26 pro mil in 2012 whereas that is 23.1 pro mil. It is 8.5 pro mil more than the national average of that (14.6 pro mil)/Statistics of the department of health 2013/
- Child death rate aged under 5 per 1000 live births is 29.1 pro mil in 2012 whereas that is 28.8 pro mil and then, it is 10.6 pro mil more than the national average of that (18.2 pro mil) /Statistics of the department of health 2013/

- The rate of child accidents is 9.9 %, and it is 5.6 5 more than the national average of that /Statistics of the department of health 2013/

- The rate of children who are likely to be fallen into a disabled child category is 23.3 % and it is 9.8 % more than the national average of that.

#### **1.2.4. Regarding household and family**

-It is claimed that the national program of family promotion aims to cover 15 % of the whole household in 2016. However, it did 1,3 % in 2012; 1,1 % in 2013. Thus, on-going achievements were not satisfactory.

-The behavior changes of targeted groups were not measured in 2012 and 2013

- The utility rate of household to be provided with enhanced sources of drinking water is 48.3% and it is 29.6% less than the national average of that.

- The utility rate of advanced toileting facilities is 60.6% and it is 23% less than the national average of that.

All these figures have shown that there are desperate needs to develop child friendly aimag strategy in Khuvsgul province.

As a result of successful implementation of the child friendly aimag strategy, all rights of child should be ensured and then all indicators should be fulfilled in 2014-2016.

## **CHAPTER TWO**

### **DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY AND GOALS FOR YEARS 2014-2016**

2.1 VISION: To become a child friendly aimag in 2016 where all child rights be guaranteed.

2.2 MISSION: To become an aimag where child friendly and safety and health environment should be established; all children should be provided with equal opportunity to cultivate physically, mentally and socially; maternal death rate should be decreased.

#### **2.3 PRIORITIES AND EXPECTED OUTCOMES:**

**2.3.1.** *Child friendly services / health, education, child development; child participation; child protection/*

#### **Expected outcomes:**

-Every organization in the aimag will have child protection policy in 2016; child crime rate in the aimag will be decreased by 54% in 2016

- Child participation and accessibility rate of activities of child led organizations will be 90%; programs in local media be designated to children in the aimag will be established and sustained.

- Enrollment rate of kindergartens in aimag will be at 92%, 70 % out of the whole kindergartens will be entitled as child friendly ones.

-Zero rate of school drop-outs and environment and conditions to provide all children with equal accesses to schooling will be guaranteed.

-A number of child deaths will be considerably decreased and its rate will reach 13.6 promel in 2016.

- 99.5% out of the whole children aged up to 1 will be fully injected by immutization; the rate of the accessibility of the vitamin to children A will be at 80% whereas that of the vitamin D will reach 95%.

- The rate of pregnant women, breast fed babies and infants under 6-23 months to use MNP under professional advice will reach 80%.

### ***2.3.2. Child friendly family***

#### **Expected outcomes:**

- 90% out of families of targeted groups with respect to family requests and opinions will be involved in basic social services. .

### ***2.3.3. Safety and health living environment***

#### **Expected outcomes:**

- All citizens and organizations in aimag will acquire basic skills and knowledge about assuring willingness to respond to potential disasters and taking actions to prevent themselves from them

- 50% out of the whole soums and administrative units will deserve to provide safety and healthy living environments for children.

### ***2.3.4. Child friendly governance***

#### **Expected outcomes:**

- The Amount of local budgets and supports and a number of policies and supports to address children will be increased by 50%

2.4.STRATEGIC PRINCIPLE: all decisions made by all government and non-governmental organizations in aimag will reflect and promote child friendly policy

All organizations committed to the strategic principle will plan and implement annually activities to promote child friendly policy.

## **2.5. IMPLEMENTATION TIMELINE**

This strategy will be functioned and fulfilled in years 2014-2016

## CHAPTER FOUR

### STRATEGIC MANAGEMENT, ORGANIZATION, MONITORING EVALUATION AND FINANCE

#### 4.1. STRATEGIC MANAGEMENT AND ORGANIZATION

All organizations, namely, UNICEF, AGO, DoE, DoH, DoCFD, SGO, DoSWS, LD, DE, DoP, Judiciary Division, and NGO will undertake duties and responsibility to develop plans initially to implement the child friendly aimag strategy and report annually to the councils of Aimag's Governor and the Local Parliament.

#### 4.2. MONITORING AND EVALUATION

Monitoring and evaluation should be annually conducted in the third quarter of year by a specially-formed taskforce and also, organizations taking part of the child friendly aimag strategy should diagnose and assess the assigned task fulfillments and their results 2 times per year, in the first and fourth quarters. Any amendments on conducting monitoring and evaluation should be made during the strategy implementation of child friendly aimag,

#### 4.3. NEEDS OF FINANCE AND SOURCES

The amount of the expenditure indispensable to implement the child friendly aimag strategy should be annually estimated and allocated into the budgets of local development fund and local organizations associated with it.

This strategy should be implemented so that all criteria and indicators for child friendly aimag be fulfilled in 2014-2016.
